Follow Up to 10/11/07 Report of Stolen Cannons!

Thank you all for your efforts and coverage of the story that the Seafair Pirates cannons had been plundered. Thanks to your wonderful viewers, our cannons have been found! They were turned into the S.W. Precinct of the Seattle Police. We will be holding a press conference at 4:30 pm on Friday November 30, 2007 at 12510 33rd Ave NE, Seattle WA 98125.

A representative of the Seattle Police Department will be present as well as the local citizen that found the cannons; Jim Love. The Moby Duck will be on display as well as the recovered cannon barrels. Though they were damaged, they will gladly be remounted aboard the Moby Duck and displayed proudly until the repairs can be made.

We will begin with a short introduction of the people involved in the recovery and a thank you to the stations that covered this story for the Seafair Pirates and their fantastic viewers. We will present a reward check to Mr. Love (provided to the Pirates by Beacon Plumbing) and then will open up for any questions. Due to the varying schedules of each station, we will be available for interviews and/or questions until 11:30 PM.
